## **International Baccalaureate Policy (IB)**

Students may be awarded UWG "K" credit for Standard Level-SL (college preparatory) courses and Higher Level-HL (college comparable) courses. Credit is awarded based on the University System of Georgia recommendations for assessment scores and provided that the academic departments determine the examinations to be comparable to courses at UWG. Syllabus evaluation is required to determine course credit for Economics. Scores of 6 and 7 are granted "Honors credit" for the UWG course equivalents.
