What is ARFS?

The Association of Retired Faculty and Staff (ARFS) at the University of West Georgia was organized in 2004 to create a climate in which all retired faculty and staff feel welcomed by and re-connected to their former institution and their fellow retirees. Its purposes are to:

- Promote the well-being of its members
- Support the University of West Georgia retiree community
- Foster continued involvement of retirees in the mission of the university
- Facilitate communication between the university and its retirees
- Seek to promote the scholarly, social, and cultural interests of the retiree community
- Address matters related to benefits and resources for retirees

How do I become a member?

All faculty and staff who have retired from UWG are eligible for membership. Membership is achieved and maintained through the provision of current contact information (email or regular mail) to the Office of Human Resources. Retirees can give consent to be contacted by ARFS at separation from UWG.

Who directs the activities of ARFS?

Activities of ARFS are directed by a Coordinating Council elected at the Annual Meeting and consisting of 5 officers (president, vice-president, past president, secretary, and treasurer) and at least 6 at-large members. All active members of ARFS are eligible for election to the council.
